Bach's 18 "Leipzig" chorale preludes were written at the end of his life. Included is a setting on the hymn *Deck Yourself, My Soul with Gladness*' (Hymn 78 in *Common Praise*) in which he treats the melody in a very ornamented way. The text for today's anthem:

Come, O Lord, and overflow us with your love; for we bring our hearts like vessels to the ever-flowing stream. Come, Lord Jesus and anoint us with your power.

The postlude, *A Saving Health To Us is Brought*, is from Bach's collection of chorale preludes for the liturgical year.
