### **TODAY'S MUSIC**

The melody for *Requiescat in Pace* is the same as our communion hymn. Henry Ley was professor of organ at the Royal College of Music. Healey Willan's anthem *O What Their Joy* uses the melody of Hymn 275 as well as 4 of the verses. For the third verse, Willan uses a faux bourdon (false melody), placing the melody in the tenor part. David Cameron's *Prelude on 'Sine Nomine'* is published in a book in memory of former Ottawa organist Gerald Bales.
