Much of Duruflé's music is based on Gregorian chant, including the introit, which features the melody played on the trumpet stop. The anthem uses some of the verses from today's gospel. It was written for the choir of Trinity Lutheran Church in Indianapolis. Andrew Fletcher's *Prelude on 'Dix'* (the hymn tune for our offertory hymn) features the melody in long notes, played by the left hand.
