TODAY'S MUSIC

Dieterich Buxtehude's *Chorale Prelude on 'How Brightly Beams the Morning Star'* is, in fact, two movements. Both movements take each phrase of the hymn tune and 'run with it' (sometimes featuring the melody in long-valued notes, sometimes in an ornamented fugal style. Dirck Janszoon Sweelinck (1591-1652)—son of the more famous organist and composer Jan Pieterszoon Sweelinck—followed his father as organist at the Oude Kirk in Amsterdam. The anthem is based on the famous hymn tune of the same name (which can be found at CP 622). Today also marks the end of *The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity*. Our communion and recessional hymns focus on this theme.
