TODAY'S MUSIC

Three anonymous pieces were put together as a suite by Edward Kendall in the late 17th century. Each piece uses a different family of stops on the organ: principals, reeds and the flutes. Today's anthem is a paraphrase of our Old Testament reading. It is arranged by Charles Wood, and is taken from a 10th century *Sanctus*. It is a metrical setting (like an hymn, in that all four sections of the choir change chords at the same time). One of Paul's most famous quotes—*by the grace of God I am what I am*—is in our epistle passage today which led to the obvious choice of the hymn *Amazing Grace*. Dale Wood's *Prelude on 'Amazing Grace'* uses lush harmonies.
