### **TODAY'S MUSIC**

St. Richard (1197-1253) was bishop of Chichester for the last 8 years of his life. His prayer reflects the commitment needed by anyone who seeks to be a true follower of Jesus. He wrote the prayer on his death bed. Bach's *Clavierübung* (Keyboard practice) is a collection of pieces that form his organ mass. The *Fughetta* (a small fugue) *on the Ten Commandments*, the theme occurs 10 times, and the first four occurrences are ten beats apart!

*O holy Jesus, most merciful redeemer, friend and brother, may I know thee more clearly, love thee more dearly and follow thee more nearly. Amen.*
