MILK CRATES NEEDED FOR STORAGE

If anyone has any milk crates that they no longer need, please bring them to church on Sunday.

The Reverend Mike Gardener was ordained in 1955 in his native England on behalf of the Bishop of the Arctic and he spent his entire ministry in Canada's Arctic. In 1955 he was posted to Lake Harbour (centre of the south coast of Baffin Island). The following year he and Margaret were married. Margaret is also from England. They were not allowed to live in the same community before they were married, so Margaret was a cook at the hospital in Pangnirtung. In 1960 they moved to Cape Dorset (southwest corner of Baffin Island) where he was the parish priest and also trained those who were going to be catechists. After 10 years they moved to Pangnirtung (situated on a coastal plain at the coast of Pangnirtung Fjord on the east coast of Baffin Island) where he continued those two ministries. In 1981 they moved to Frobisher Bay (now known as Iqaluit) where he trained Inuit clergy and then served as rector of St. Jude's Cathedral and Dean of the Diocese of the Arctic. Mike retired in 1996. He and Margaret have 3 daughters, 9 grandchildren and 8 great-grandchildren. He is bilingual (English and Inuktitut).
