TODAY'S MUSIC

Bach wrote several trios for the organ: one voice in each hand, and one in the pedals. His *Trio in D Minor* is an early work. The music for *Eternal Lord of Love* (Hymn 174) was composed by Michael Joncas, a Roman Catholic priest. Perhaps his most famous hymn in *On Eagle's Wings*. *Cwm Rhondda* (cwm means low valley; Rhondda is an urban district in the south of Wales) is the name of the tune for our recessional hymn. Wilbur Held's setting come from the 2-volume collection of 6 hymn tune settings *Those Wonderful Welsh*.
