TODAY'S MUSIC

César Franck (1822-2890) was organist at St. Clotilde Church in Paris. A new direction in organ building had recently developed in France in the mid 19th century and Franck took advantage of it, and was the first of many organists to compose for this orchestrally-styled organ. The *Cantabile* was composed in 1878. *This Joyful Eastertide* uses words by George R Woodford. The tune is a Dutch melody from *David's Psalmen*, Amsterdam of 1685, arranged by Charles Wood. Our processional hymn uses the Welsh hymn tune *St. Denio*. Wilbur Held's *Prelude on St. Denio* comes from a collection of 12 hymn tune settings titled *Those Wonderful Welsh*.
