TODAY'S MUSIC

The Fourth Sunday of Easter—also known as *Good Shepherd Sunday*—focuses on Jesus as a shepherd. *Brother James's Air* is a Scottish melody that is often used for the text of Psalm 23. Searle Wright's *Prelude on Brother James's Air* features the melody on the clarinet rank of pipes. Larry Long bases his arrangement of Psalm 23 on an Afro-American spiritual. C. S. Lang's *Tuba Tune* shows off the trumpet stop on the organ. In organ music, tuba is Latin for trumpet and English organs are known for their tuba stops that are usually on a much higher wind pressure than other ranks of pipes on the organ. (Our organ doesn't have a tuba stop *per se*, but a pretty decent trumpet stop.)
