### **TODAY'S MUSIC**

June 8, 2010 is the bicentennial of the birth of Robert Schumann. His desire to study the music of Bach resulted in composing some music for organ or pedal-piano. He wrote six fugues on the theme BACH. Though the musical alphabet as we know it only goes up to G, the Germans take it up to H. (B = B-flat, and H = B natural.) Several composers (including Franz Liszt and Max Reger) wrote pieces based on BACH. William France was organist of Dominion-Chalmers United Church from 1950-80. His *Prelude on 'Slane'* is taken from a volume of music in memory of Toronto organist Charles Peaker that was published by the Royal Canadian College of Organists.
