Frances Macdonnell, BA, FRCO, FRCCO (hon. causa), was Organist and Choir Director of Christ Church Cathedral from 1980 - 2003. Now retired, she acts as a free-lance organist, playing at other churches as requested, and finds life very busy! She still conducts the Cathedral Singers of Ottawa, a mixed-voice chamber choir which operates out of Christ Church Cathedral. She sits on the National Council of the Royal Canadian College of Organists, and is active on the National Examinations Committee.

Wesley R. Warren has performed extensively throughout Canada, in the United states, Britain and Europe. He is Organist and Choirmaster at St. Barnabas Anglican Church, Ottawa, Lecturer in Music and Western Culture at Augustine College, and Instructor in Organ at Carleton University. An honours graduate in organ performance of the University of Toronto and the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, he has received many prizes and awards, and was winner of the RCCO National Playing Competition in 1981. He is broadcast frequently on CBC Radio and has been a performer at several RCCO National Conventions. In the summer of 2007, Mr. Warren was Organist-in-residence at Winchester Cathedral, U.K., and performed in recital on their concert series.
