She sang with Opera Lyra chorus for several seasons after her retirement from the N.A.C. orchestra and is now a permanent member of the Orchestra of Northern New York in Potsdam.

**MARY PAT GRIMES** was born in Ottawa and began studying violin at seven years of age. She performs with the Valley Festival Orchestra and held the concertmaster post with the Ottawa Chamber Orchestra for three years. Her local music agency, *Ambiance Classical Music* keeps her busy on weekends and evenings playing at weddings, social functions and fundraising events. She particularly enjoys her time as an ensemble player and looks forward to expanding her chamber music repertoire. During the day, Mary Pat runs her own company as a Graphic Design Production Artist, working primarily for Canada Post and Alcatel-Lucent.

**ROBERT JONES** is organist and choir director of St. Luke's Church, plays for the Saturday mass at St. Basil's Church (Maitland Avenue), and is the conductor of two community choirs: The Bytown Voices and the Seaway Valley Singers. He also directs the two handbell choirs at Winchester United Church. Bob is also active in the Royal Canadian College of Organists, serving on the executive of the Ottawa Centre.
